A LOOK BACK



Main Street Hartland, MN in 1914; the population in the 1910 census was 227. Hartland was settled in the spring of 1857 and organized May 11, 1858. It was named after a town called Hartland in Windsor County, Vermont, where many of the early settlers came from; the name was proposed by the wife of O. Sheldon, the first postmaster.
